- A. Call to Order and Introductions Board Vice Chair Mark Millan (Windsor) called the meeting to order at 9:05 AM
- **B.** Approval of the Agenda Mark Millan requested that the Board approve the agenda. The agenda was unanimously approved.

C. Approval of Standing Items

- Minutes: December 8 Board of Directors Meetings
 - i. The Board unanimously approved the minutes from the December 8 Board of Directors Meeting.
- D. Guest Presentation: "Sonoma County Water Climate Adaptation Plans" Laura Harnish, CH2M
 - Laura Harnish (CH2M) described a Sonoma County Water Agency (SCWA) project to develop a Climate Adaptation Plan, a forward-looking roadmap for SCWA assessment of climate risks and potential adaptation strategies. The development is anticipated to take 18 months and will follow a five-step framework: problem scoping, hazard understanding and mapping, vulnerability and risk assessment, adaptation strategy development, and implementation and monitoring.

- Lunch meeting with NCRWQCB: February 21
 - i. Andy Rodgers (RRWA) summarized updates from the NCRWQCB meeting.
- North Coast Resources Partnership (NCRP) update
 - i. The next NCRP meeting will be held on April 20 at the Westside Water Education Center in Sonoma County.
- Review 2017 2018 draft Work Plan
 - i. Andy Rodgers summarized changes to the Work Plan since the Board's review on December 8.
 - ii. At the Technical Working Group (TWG) meeting on February 14, the TWG recommended adoption of the Work Plan.
 - iii. Kevin Doble (Ukiah) moved that the Board adopt the 2017-18 Work Plan. Pam Stafford (Rohnert Park) seconded. There was unanimous approval.
 - iv. RRWA Staff are available to meet with individual agencies to review the final Work Plan.

F. Russian River Stormwater Resources Management and Monitoring Plan

- Prop 1 Stormwater Resource Plan (SWRP)
 - i. Andy Rodgers provided an overview of the SWRP project. The City of Ukiah, on behalf of RRWA, was awarded a \$500,000 Proposition 1 grant to prepare a regional SWRP. Matching funds bring the project total to \$1.2 million. The goal of the SWRP is to identify projects that capture and re-use stormwater runoff and provide multiple benefits.
 - ii. An executed contract with the State of California is anticipated soon.
- Russian River Regional Monitoring Program (R3MP) update
 - i. Andy Rodgers provided an overview of the R3MP project. The NCRWQCB was awarded a discretionary funding grant. The San Francisco Estuary Institute (SFEI) is under contract with the NCRWQCB to facilitate the development of an R3MP.
 - ii. The R3MP kick off meeting for technical staff will be held on March 8.
- Stormwater Program
 - i. Andy Rodgers provided an update on four of the requirements of the regional MS4 Phase I Stormwater Permit where RRWA is providing support, including:
 - 1. The Laguna Mark West Monitoring and Reporting Work Plan has been drafted and is currently being reviewed by NCRWQCB.
 - 2. RRWA Staff are collecting data and will prepare a Draft 1 Trash Assessment Report. A subcommittee meeting will be held on March 14th to determine next steps.
 - 3. A draft Ethnic Community Outreach Work Plan has been prepared. A subcommittee meeting will be held on March 14 to determine next steps.
 - 4. LID trainings for municipal staff and the design community are tentatively scheduled for March and April, respectively. RRWA Staff will announce the dates when finalized.
