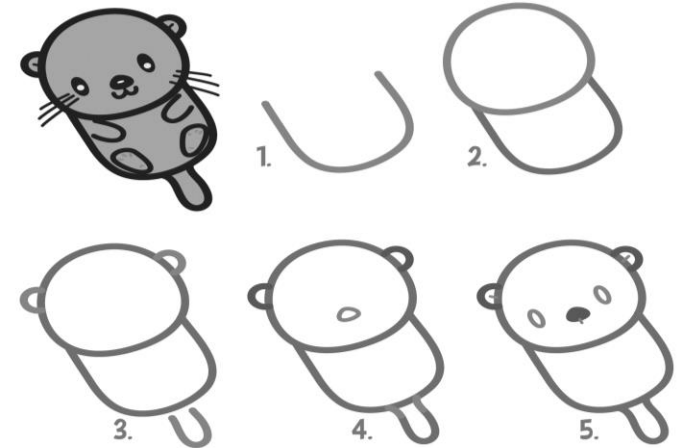

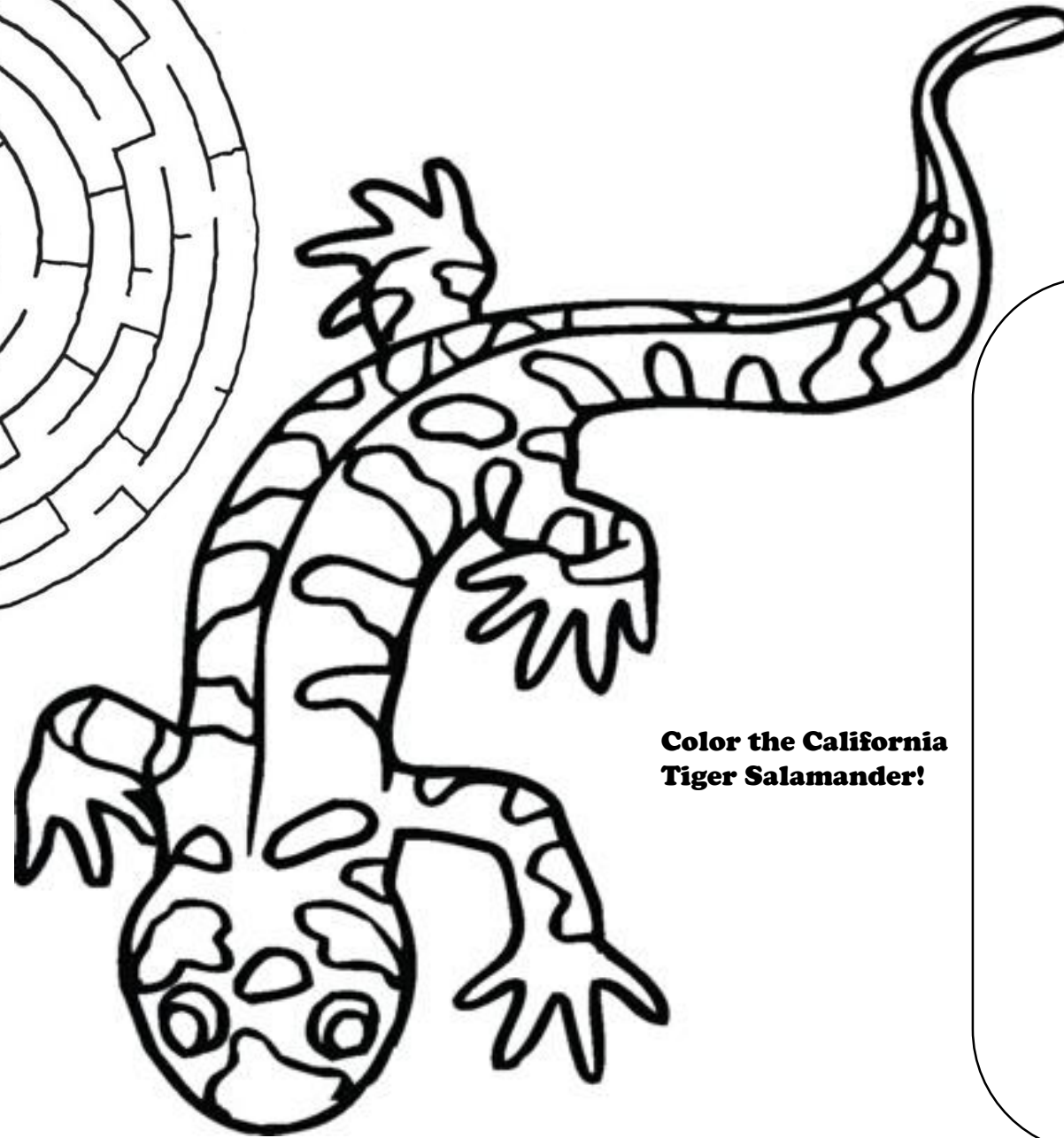
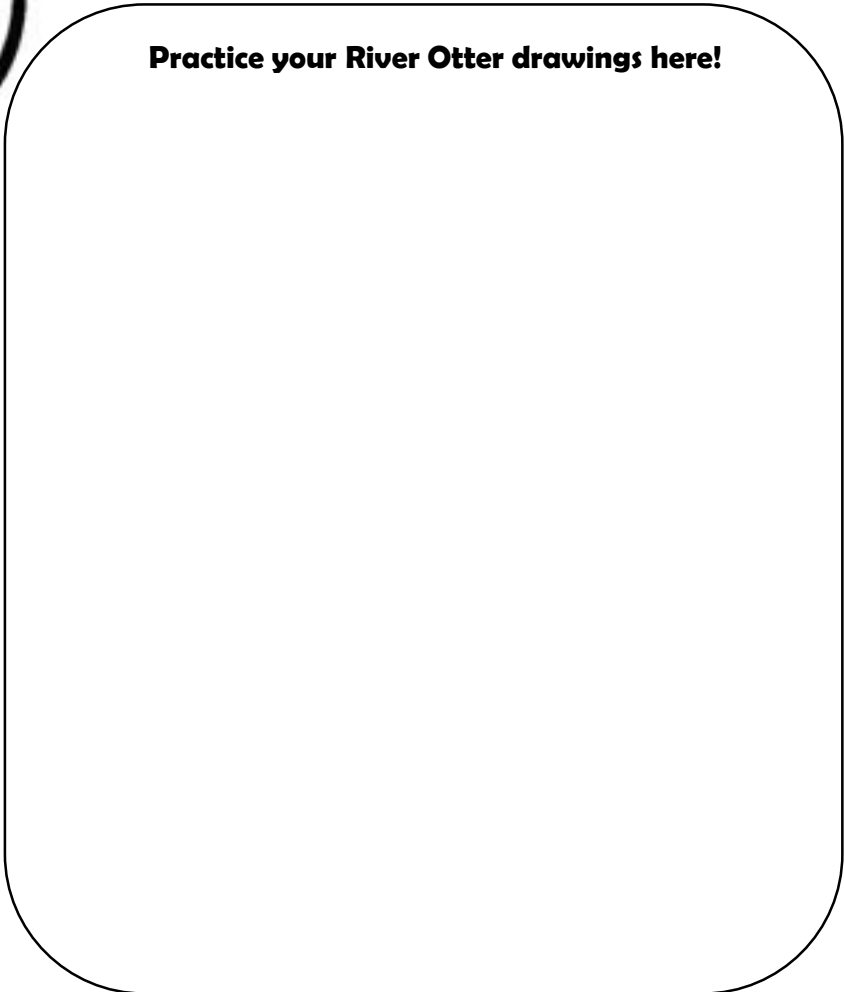

Learn to draw a River Otter

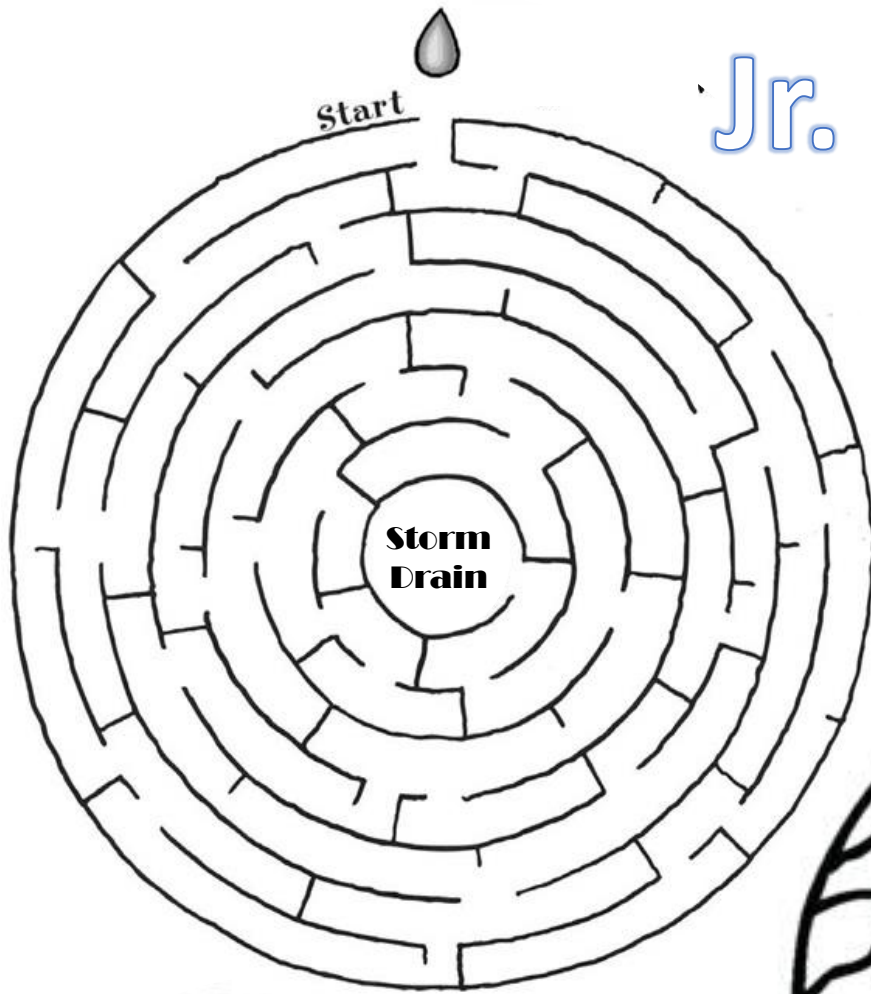
Welcome to the Russian River Watershed!

The Russian River watershed is habitat for the California tiger salamander, an endangered species.

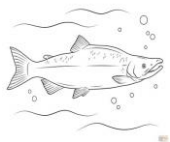


There are about 360,000 people who live in the Russian River watershed. * The Russian River is habitat for fish including Steelhead, Chinook and Coho salmon.

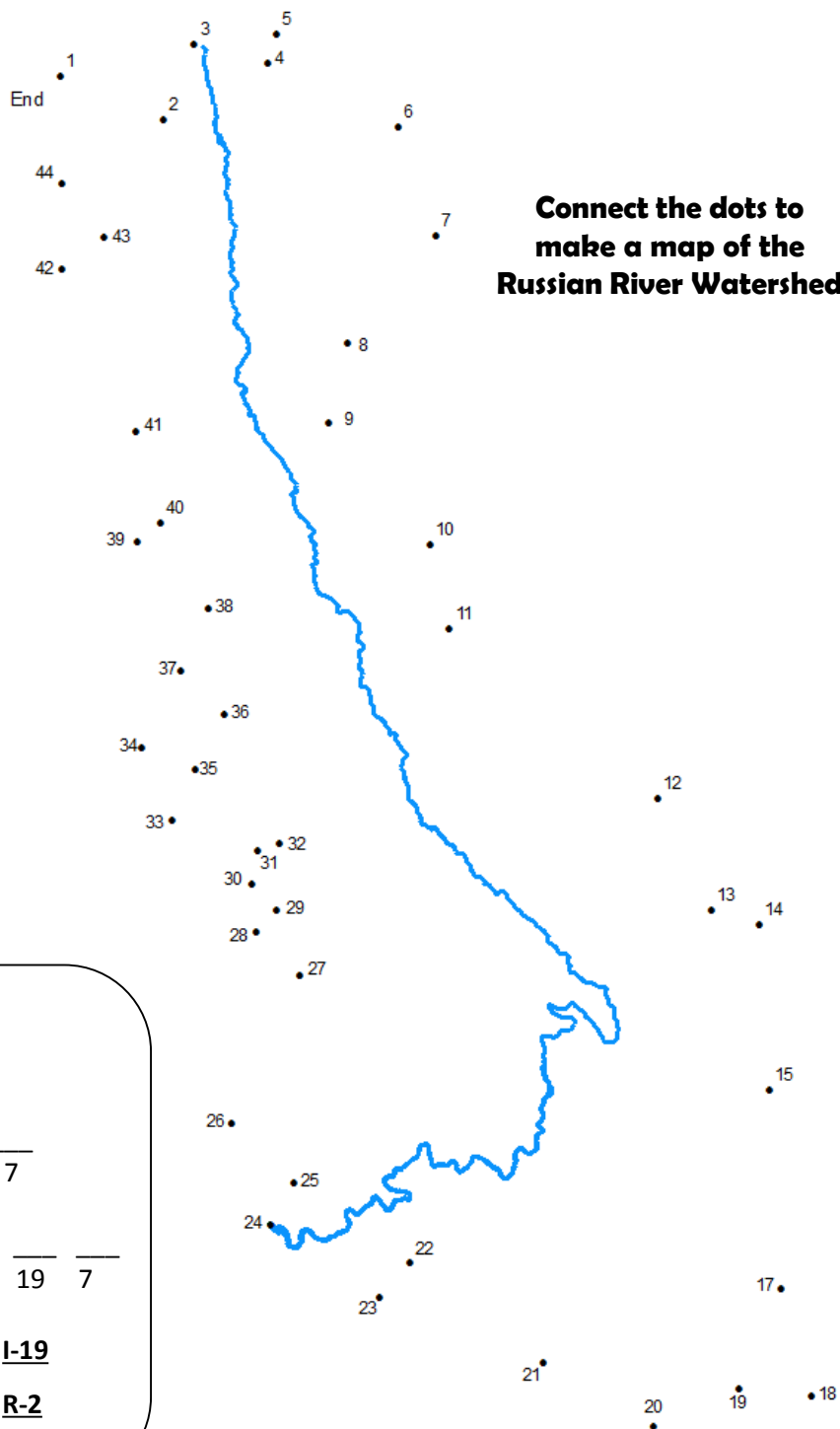

When it rains, the water enters the storm drain and goes straight to our rivers and creeks. * This is called storm water runoff.

Only rain should go down the storm drain to keep our rivers and creeks free of pollutants.



A watershed is all of the land that drains to a single water body. * Watersheds cover all of the earth's land which mean you live in a watershed!
