Andy (RRWA) is considering the possibility of combining the December TWG and BOD meeting.

3. February BOD Meeting Update

- 2020/2021 Workplan adoption—The narrative portion of the workplan is pending. RRWA staff will send the final draft to the group.
- New member charter and resolution draft adoption—Drafts have been posted to the RRWA SharePoint.
- Emergency trash bin funds repurposed for Clean River Alliance truck outfitting— The \$5,000 check has been provided to Russian Riverkeeper.
- Executive Director review—RRWA staff is developing templates for the Board Ad Hoc. Additional information will be shared as the process moves forward.
- TWG and subcommittees roles and responsibilities review—Andy (RRWA) is looking to obtain Board perspective on the TWG role.

4. Storm Water Program Updates

• Co-permittee meeting—A majority of the discussion was centered around compliance with the storm water permit relative to shelter-in-place.

• Effectiveness Assessment—This task is on pause until further notice; No hard date to continue. The discussion to resume task will take place when shelter-in-place is lifted. Incumber funds for the next workplan year.

5. Russian River Watershed Coordination

- Regional Monitoring Program (R3MP)
 - Next meeting TBD—No progress at this time. Nick (Rohnert Park) suggested looking at outcomes of shelter-in-place with water quality board. Brendan (RWQCB) suggested putting the impacts of shelter-in-place with water quality compliance in writing. Group decided to be table this topic for now.
- Storm Water Resource Plan Adaptive Management—NCRP can provide funding to adaptively manage the SWRP. Other contributions are needed to fully fund this work. RRWA has a small funding source that could support the projects that still need to be incorporated into the SWRP. Andy will send an email with a plan outline.
- SSU Rising WATERS project— Project is fully funded and still moving forward. Possible CASQA abstract. The framework for a workplan has been drafted, but not a detailed workplan. The TWG would like to be active in the development of the workplan.
- 303(d) List of Impaired Water Bodies—The draft list is available for public comment. New listings were reviewed with the TWG. No direction on providing comments was given to RRWA staff.
