THE CONTEST:

The winning videos will serve as public service announcements (PSA) and be featured on TV.

To win: Your video must teach the public the difference between our local storm drain system and the sanitary sewer system. You can create a newscast, skit, animation, commercial, reality television show, or even a music video. Let your imagination go wild, but please read all of the following instructions carefully!

SUBMISSION DEADLINE: 5:00PM, FRIDAY, APRIL 9TH, 2021

WHO MAY ENTER:

Students in grades 9th- 12th attending high school in Sonoma, southern Mendocino, or northern Marin counties.

ENTRY GUIDELINES:

- Length must be exactly 55 seconds (this includes the required closing scene).
- Entries can be an individual or team effort. Max of 5 students per video and one video entry per person.
- All entries must be student-created. No professional assistance accepted.
- Copyright material of any medium (music, images, video clips, etc.) is not allowed.
- Entries should be exported as a single file in the highest quality. Preferred formats include: .mp4, .mpg, .wmv, .avi.
- Entries can be submitted via: our online form, through a file sharing site such as sendspace.com, dropsend.com, or hightail.com, or on a USB drive. USB drives will not be returned. Multiple videos can be placed on one USB drive.
- DO NOT delete your original project file until the winners of the contest have been announced. If you place, you may be asked to make modifications to your entry.

CLOSING SCENE:

The closing scene must feature:

- The RRWA logo (please do not modify the logo from its original form)
- And the text: "For more information about your water, please visit: www.rrwatershed.org"

A completed release form must be submitted *for every contributor* involved in the production of the video. Please visit our website to download a copy of this form.

PSA JUDGING CRITERIA:

Entries will be judged by an independent review committee. Please consider the following:

- Does your PSA teach the audience the difference between our local storm drain system and the sanitary sewer system?
- Did you conduct research to make sure your facts are accurate? Please check the authenticity of every website you use.
- Did you include the tagline? "Know Where Water Goes"
- Is your PSA entertaining, creative, and original?
- Is the audio and technical construction clear and of high quality? Please make sure your images are not blurry or pixelated.
- Is your text clear, visible, and easy for the audience to read?
- Did you include the proper closing scene?
- Did you fill out a release form for each person involved in the production of the video?

PRIZES:

Cash awards will be split with 50% of the prize money going to the individual(s) who submitted the video and 50% to the high school they attend.
